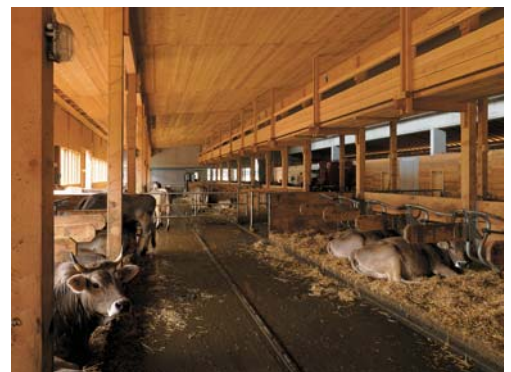

An outstanding building was created for the vocational school in Vouvry VS, which has a sports hall at its centre. Natural light shines through the ceiling and onto two surrounding walkways. Since then, the team has designed a number of other inventive buildings.

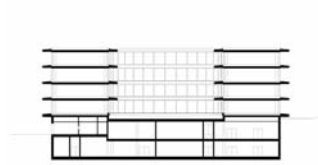
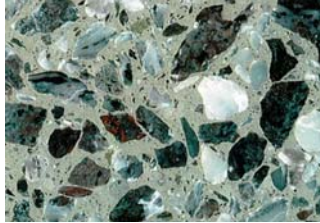
